

WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a small file containing information about pages of this website and is stored on the hard drive of your computer. The stored information can be used by the website the next time you visit.

USE OF PERSISTENT COOKIES

By using a permanent cookie we can recognize you the next time you visit our website. The website can therefore be set specifically to your preferences. If you have given permission for the placement of cookies we can do this by using a cookie to remember the settings. Because of this, you do not always have to repeat your action for your preferences. This saves you time and therefore a more pleasant use of our website. Persistent cookies can be removed through the settings of your browser.

USE OF SESSION COOKIES

Using a session cookie, we can see which parts of the site you have viewed this visit. We can customize our service so far as possible on the surfing behavior of our visitors. These cookies are automatically deleted once you exit your Web browser.

GOOGLE ANALYTICS

Through our website, a cookie is placed by the U.S. company Google, as part of the Analytics service. We use this service to track and to get reports about how visitors use the website. Google may transfer this information to third parties where Google is legally required or if third parties process the information on Google's behalf. We have no influence on this. We did not allow Google to use the analytics information obtained on other Google services.

The information we collect is anonymous as much as possible. Your IP address is not explicitly given. The information is transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google states adhere to the Safe Harbor Principles and is affiliated to the Safe Harbor program of the U.S. Department of Commerce. This means that there is an adequate level of protection for the processing of any personal data.
